1.0 Overview of Canada Council funding to Ontario in 2007-08

- In 2007-08, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants totalling \$51 million to the arts in Ontario.
- In addition to grants, \$2.8 million in payments was provided to 5,606 authors through the Public Lending Right program,¹ as well as \$1.5 million in special funds in 2007-08. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Ontario to \$55.2 million.
- The Canada Council awarded \$6.8 million in grants to 653 Ontario artists and \$44.2 million to 650 Ontario arts organizations in 2007-08.
- Grants were awarded to artists and arts organizations in Ontario in each artistic discipline – dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, interdisciplinary and performance art and writing and publishing. In 2007-08, the largest amount of funding went to music (\$12.6 million). Theatre received the second largest amount of funding (\$9.6 million), followed by writing and publishing (\$8.2 million).
- 4,295 applications from Ontario artists and arts organizations were submitted to the Canada Council in 2007-08, representing 29.1% of the total number of applications received.
- Funding to artists and arts organizations in Toronto totalled \$34.6 million in 2007-08, comprising 67.8% of the total funding going to the province. Ottawa received \$3.5 million in funding, representing 6.9% of total funding, and Stratford received \$1.4 million in funds (2.7%). 143 additional communities in Ontario received 22.6% of the province's funding for a total of \$11.5 million.
- In 2007-08, Ontario artists received 29.1% of Canada Council funding to artists, and Ontario arts organizations received 34.1% of the funding to arts organizations. In total, Ontario artists and arts organizations received 33.4% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up 38.8% of the Canadian population² and 40.2% of Canadian artists.³
- 209 Ontario artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 2007-08, making up 27.1% of all peer assessors. 90% of Ontarian assessors were Anglophone, and 10% of assessors were Francophone.

2.0 Statistical highlights about the arts in Ontario⁴

- With 52,500 artists, Ontario has nearly twice as many artists as any other province. Artists represent 0.8% of the provincial labour force, equal to the national average.
- Toronto has an artistic concentration (1.6%) that is double the national average of 0.8%, ranking the city fifth among large Canadian cities. Ottawa (1.0%), Waterloo (1.0%) and Kingston (0.9%) also have an artistic concentration that is above the national average, Ottawa and Waterloo are tied for tenth in Canada.
- 40% of the province's artists reside in Toronto, compared with 21% of the province's overall labour force. In terms of the absolute number of artists, the City of Toronto has about twice as many artists (21,000) as the City of Montreal (10,100), with Vancouver (7,300) having the third-highest number of artists.
- In Toronto, Niagara Falls, Peterborough and Kingston, the growth in the arts labour force between 1991 and 2001 was at least 10 times the growth in the overall local labour force. In Toronto, the growth in the arts labour force was 13 times the growth in the city's overall labour force.
- Among large Ontario cities, artists' average earnings are highest in Toronto (\$34,100, the highest level in Canada), Ajax (\$31,800, the third-highest level in Canada), Pickering (\$31,000, the fourth-highest level in Canada) and Ottawa (\$29,700, the fifth-highest level in Canada).
- Ontarians spent \$10.2 billion on cultural goods and services in 2005, 41% of the Canadian total. Cultural spending represents 3.0% of total consumer spending in the province. The \$10.2 billion in consumer spending on culture is over three times larger than the \$3.0 billion spent on culture in Ontario by all levels of government in 2003-04. At \$851 per resident, Ontarians' per capita cultural spending is third among the provinces.
- In 2005, the three most popular cultural and heritage activities in Ontario were: reading newspapers (88% of the population 15 or older); listening to music on CD's, cassette tapes, DVD audio discs, records, etc. (83%); and watching a video (rented, purchased, VHS or DVD formats) (80%).
- In 2005, 43% of Ontarians 15 or older (4.31 million residents) attended a concert or performance by professional artists of music, dance, theatre or opera (excluding cultural festivals). This is slightly higher than the Canadian rate of 41%.

Examples of Canada Council funding in Ontario⁵

The Canada Council supports the endeavours of professional artists and arts organizations through its programs. The following selection illustrates the scope of the activities supported by the Canada Council in Ontario.

The **Textile Museum of Canada** in Toronto was awarded **\$15,000** in 2007-08 for a total two-year grant of **\$25,000** through the **Visual Arts - Supplementary Operating Funds Initiative**. This support enabled the museum to engage disadvantaged youth in its **Digital Threads** project, a workshop and competition with an online component. In the fall of 2007, 26 students from Toronto's Parkdale Collegiate Institute were challenged to integrate electronic circuits and transmitters into fabrics to create an electronic textile that could hide or reveal personal identity. Students collaborated with Montreal artist **Joanna Berzowska** and with design, fashion and new media students from the Ontario College of Art & Design, Ryerson University and Sheridan College. Students shared feedback and discoveries through blogging, and the winning work was exhibited at the Textile Museum in April 2008.

Darcey Callison of Toronto received a **\$30,000 Production Project Grant in Dance** to conduct the second and third phases of **The Zoo Project** in 2007-08. **The Zoo Project** is an original choreography that includes projected images and an original sound score and investigates the construction of danced masculinity in Hollywood films. In the first phase of the project, **Callison** and five dancers reconstructed performances by male Hollywood dancers, from Gene Kelly, to Marlon Brando, John Travolta and Patrick Swayze, then reinterpreted them in a piece speaking to the construction of masculinity. **Callison** will continue to construct and deconstruct Hollywood choreography to synthesize the research outcomes of the previous phases into a larger original choreography for performance.

Frédérique Annie Vézina of Toronto received **\$5,000** as the winner of the 2007 **Bernard Diamant Prize**. The prize offers outstanding young professional Canadian classical singers an opportunity to pursue their career through further studies and is awarded on top of a regular grant. **Vézina** also received **\$16,000** from the **Grants to Professional Musicians (Individuals) - Classical Music of all World Cultures** program to pursue an Artist Diploma at the Juilliard Opera Center in New York City for 10 months beginning in August 2007. Through the **Travel Grants to Professional Musicians** program, **Vézina** received an additional **\$1,000 in funding** to participate in the Opera Studio of the Centre for Opera in Sulmona, Italy in June and July 2007.

In 2007-08, Barrie's **Talk is Free Theatre** received **\$6,000** through the **Theatre Production Project Grants: Emerging Artists' Development/Production** program to develop ***Shumskawsling***, an original play by deaf emerging playwright Michael Cyr. Cyr's play presents a post-apocalyptic world where half of the population is deaf. Part satire and part murder mystery, the production is written in both English and American Sign Language (ASL) and features a cast of four hearing and four deaf actors. **Talk is Free Theatre** sought to present deafness as a culture, not a handicap, to make the work of deaf artists more accessible to a wider audience and to allow unrestricted access to its production for members of the deaf community. ***Shumskawsling*** was performed from February 28 to March 8, 2008.

Through the **Theatre Touring and Special Initiatives Program**, Sudbury's **Théâtre du Nouvel-Ontario Inc. (TNO)** received **\$3,500** to present its production, ***Spitting Slag***, at Montreal's Théâtre La Licorne in April 2008. ***Spitting Slag*** was written by Mansel Robinson and was translated for **TNO** by renowned Franco-Ontarian author and actor Jean Marc Dalpé. Set in Sudbury, the play mixes poeticism and harsh reality as it tells the story of a man seeking justice for the death of his son in a mining accident. **TNO** aims to enrich the artistic scene in the Sudbury area. As a francophone company outside of Quebec, it felt that presenting in Montreal was essential to making the external connections needed to stimulate creativity, circulate productions and solidify its professional reputation.

\$12,500 from the **Japan-Canada Fund** was awarded to the **Jun/Ken Arts Collective** of Toronto. The Fund is used to support artistic activity that reinforces ties between the arts communities of the two countries. The **Jun/Ken Arts Collective**, a seven person collective of Japanese and Canadian artists, curators, consultants and educators, was formed to facilitate the development of the ***Water Wood Paper: Mokuhanga*** exhibition to be held in October and November 2008 at the Japan Foundation. The exhibition will present international work in contemporary Japanese woodblock printmaking (mokuhanga). In conjunction with the exhibition, the collective will also produce an exhibition catalogue and organize public lectures, workshops and a professional development event for Toronto Visual Art teachers.

A **Dance Touring Grant** of **\$95,000** was awarded to **Toronto Dance Theatre (TDT)** to tour ***Timecode Break*** to Alberta, British Columbia and the Northwest Territories in February and March 2008. ***Timecode Break*** combines a funky electronic score with projected images and 12 dancers who often dance in unison or in partnership with their digital selves. The mix of live and video dance allows jumps, sudden falls and sharp footwork to co-exist with moments of stillness. To reach out to remote communities of the Northwest Territories, after performing in Yellowknife, **TDT** dancers visited Inuvik, Hay River and Behchoko to conduct student workshops, and evening dance classes for adults. **TDT** also received a **Dance Touring Grant – International** of **\$18,500** to bring ***Timecode Break*** to the United Kingdom in April 2008.

Through the **Travel Grants to Professional Musicians** program, **James Bunton** of Toronto received **\$750** to participate in the Banff Centre's first Indie Band Residency Program in Alberta. **Bunton's** seven member band, **Ohbijou**, spent February 24 to March 10, 2008 at the Centre writing, developing and recording new works. Typical of indie bands, **Ohbijou** had never before worked in a fully-equipped studio. The Centre offered state-of-the-art facilities and equipment and the expertise of experienced producers **Tony Berg** of Montreal and **Howard Bilerman** of Los Angeles. **Ohbijou** members also benefited from this time to focus exclusively on their art and develop their working style as a group.

Hamilton sound artist and radio producer **Victoria Fenner** participated in the International Association of Women in Radio and Television (IAWRT) conference in Nairobi, Kenya, in September and October 2007 with **\$2,500** awarded through the **Travel Grants to Media Artists** program. IAWRT is a forum for personal contact and professional development of women broadcasters worldwide, with a majority of its members from developing nations. While IAWRT had previously focused more on traditional methods of radio broadcasting (news reports, documentary, etc.), **Fenner** was invited this year to discuss sound art and creative radio production techniques. **Fenner** gave a presentation on audio art in Canada and participated in a panel discussion on the use of the Internet for art and journalism.

The **Visual Arts** section awarded **\$1,500** to **Raymond Schryer** of Sault Ste Marie through the **Travel Grant to Professional Artists** program to serve as a jury member for the International Violin Making Competition in Dolny Kubin, Slovakia, in April 2007. Because of his accomplishments as an instrument maker, **Schryer** was chosen as one of five jury members for this competition, where he was responsible for judging the workmanship and tone of violins. **Schryer** also displayed one of his violins in an exhibition featuring the work of the jury members, and gave a technical presentation of the process he uses to produce copies of Stradivari violins.

Toronto's **Alphabet City Media Inc. (AbC)** was awarded two **\$10,000 Project Grants for Organizations in the Visual Arts** for the 2007 **FOOD** festival and accompanying publication. **AbC** seeks to advance the visual arts by connecting them to current issues, other artistic disciplines, the sciences and public policy. **AbC** chooses one topic yearly as the theme for a multidisciplinary art and ideas festival and for a visual anthology that is distributed internationally. The **FOOD** festival, which ran from September 28 to October 20, included seven visual art exhibitions, six performing arts events and nine community events. It was **AbC's** largest festival to date. The **FOOD** anthology, co-published with MIT Press, won awards from the Alcuin Society, the Advertising and Design Club of Canada and the Gourmand World Cookbook Awards.

In 2007-08, the **Inter-Arts** office awarded a **Multidisciplinary ACCP - Artists and Community Collaboration Program** grant of **\$22,000** to **Hermione Presents**, a collective of established performing, visual and media artists in the Stratford region. Their project, ***Have we Forgotten? : The Hope Project***, used the 90th anniversary of the Battle of Vimy Ridge as the springboard for a collaborative, interdisciplinary, inter-generational, community arts exploration. Professional artists, students from St. Mary's District Collegiate & Vocational Institute, WWII and Vietnam War conscientious objectors, and soldiers and survivors from current conflicts joined to discuss individual empowerment towards peace. These discussions culminated in a live, public, interactive presentation on May 11 and 12, 2007.

Through the **Inter-Arts Program: Travel Grants to Professional Artists**, **Pamela Patterson** of Bloomfield received **\$1,500** to present her work, ***Traversing "body" Worlds***, from March 8 to 12, 2008 in London, England. Her performance piece examines the effects of aging, medical interventions and cancer on the body through the lens of feminist theory and artistic practice. **Patterson** uses reflective, interactive strategies to question the female body image and uses her own body as "art and artist, signifier and significant." **Patterson** presented her work with the Chelsea Arts Club, the Tate Modern, the American Intercontinental University and the Graeae Theatre Company. According to **Patterson**, the work changed viewers' pre-existing ideas about performance/inter-arts and encouraged interest in it as an artform.

A **\$6,550** grant through the **Audience and Market Development Travel Grants Program: International** was awarded to Toronto's **Autorickshaw** to perform at the Stockholm Jazz Festival in Sweden on July 19, 2007. The world music ensemble is comprised of vocalist **Suba Sankaran**, tabla player **Ed Hanley**, bassist **Rich Brown** and percussionist **Patrick Graham**. **Autorickshaw** received a Juno Award (2004) and a Canadian Indie Music Award (2005) for their unique combination of jazz, funk, and the classical and popular traditions of India. In Sweden, the group developed relationships with European jazz and world music presenters. Audiences and critics responded favourably to the music, and the group expects that more international touring opportunities will result.

The **Wikwemikong Heritage Organization** of Wikwemikong, Manitoulin Island received **\$10,000** through the **Elder/Youth Legacy Program: Support for Aboriginal Artistic Practices** for the **Jingle Dress, Drum & Lodge Program**. Running from August 24 to 31, 2007, the program allowed two Elders to share their roles and responsibilities during the traditional Jingle Dress ceremony with participants from the **Waasa Naabin Youth Centre**. Youth from the centre learned about the traditions of the Jingle Dress ceremony, including the making of the three types of Jingle Dresses, the Grandfather Drum and lodge construction. According to the **Wikwemikong Heritage Organization's** cultural programmer **Cynthia Bell**, the youth built everlasting relationships with the Elders and will now cherish their traditional knowledge.

4.0 Overall arts and culture funding to Ontario by all three levels of government⁶

- Arts and culture funding to Ontario from all three levels of government stood at about \$3.0 billion in 2003-04 (the latest year of overall data from Statistics Canada).
- Federal funding made up the largest share at 49% (about \$1.5 billion) followed by municipal funding at 30% (\$877.5 million) and provincial funding at 21% (\$628.3 million).
- Federal government cultural funding to Ontario totalling \$1.5 billion is primarily concentrated (83%) in three areas – broadcasting, heritage resources (historic parks/sites and nature/provincial parks) and film and video. The remaining 17% of funding is allocated to areas including performing arts (\$91.0 million), literary arts (\$81.1 million) and multidisciplinary arts (\$20.6 million). In the comparable year (2003-04), Canada Council funding accounted for about 2.85% of all federal culture spending in Ontario.
- Between 1999-00 and 2003-04, federal cultural spending in Ontario increased from \$1.1 billion to \$1.5 billion (an increase of 36%). During the same period, Canada Council funding in Ontario increased substantially from \$33.6 million in 1999-00 to \$41.7 million in 2003-04.
- The largest part of provincial government funding is primarily concentrated (85%) in three areas, libraries, heritage resources and broadcasting at \$535.6 million. However, the provincial government also allocated funds to performing arts (\$35.6 million), multidisciplinary arts (\$20.9 million) and arts education (\$15.3 million).

5.0 Detailed tables of Canada Council funding to Ontario

Canada Council for the Arts funding to Ontario

- Since 1999-00, Canada Council funding to Ontario has increased, rising from \$33.6 million to \$51 million in 2007-08 (an increase of 51.73%).
- Grants to Ontario as a percentage of total Canada Council funding slightly varied in the past nine fiscal years, going from 32.37% to 34.51%. At 33.35% in 2007-08, it has been very stable for the sixth year in a row.

Grant applications from Ontario

- For the fourth consecutive year since 1999-00 the total number of grant applications from Ontario artists and arts organizations is below 30%. Representing 29.08% of total Canada Council grant applications in 2007-08, Ontario's share of grant applications is considerably below its share of population (38.83%) and its share of artists (40.20%) – see Table 7.

Ontario – Various comparisons with other provinces⁷

- Ontario is in eighth place in terms of its level of Canada Council grant funding on a per capita basis per province at \$3.98. Its share of grant funding is higher than its share of grant applications and significantly lower than the province's percentage share of population and percentage share of artists.
